Checking in Machine:

Facebook/Twitter

Nomad/Weekly Blister Pack Prescriptions

There was some concern about some elderly patients that were on weekly blister packs who were now receiving them monthly. Connie explained this decision had come from the Clinical Commissioning Group (Previously the Primary Care Trust) to help save the NHS some money. However, Connie reassured everyone that there are some patients who have been kept on weekly prescriptions as they were not suitable to be moved to monthly so if anyone has any concerns over a friend/ relative/ themselves that have been changed, please contact the chemist who will in turn do an assessment and contact the GP.

Practice Booklet

Michelle was asked if we still have a practice booklet with the Doctors qualifications in etc. Michelle explained that we do, however we no longer use a company (due to not being able to make changes), so whereby previously it was a small A5 booklet we now have our own A4 ones. Please see reception if anyone would like one.

District Nurses

Michelle was asked if the District Nurses work from the surgery. Michelle explained they work from Park Practice and are just assigned to the surgery. We only have the same contact number patients have.

Westham Surgery
