

We offer Cervical screening here at the surgery it could save your life, so when you receive your invitation don't delay book an appointment TODAY.

Cervical Screening is offered to women

aged 25 to 49 – every 3 years

aged 50 to 64 - every 5 years

over 65 – only women who have recently had abnormal tests.

We are now able to offer extended hours appointments evenings and weekends. These are held at Park Practice, Hampden Park and Harbour Practice, Eastbourne (other practices are available outside Eastbourne). If you would like to book one of these appointments then please ring us on our usual number or see one of the reception team. (please note you can't book to see your own GP).



FOR INDICATION ONLY

When patients ring the surgery the GPs have requested that all telephonists/receptionists ask patients for a brief indication of the problem. This is to enable staff to determine who the most appropriate clinician is. Therefore, you may be offered an appointment with either our Paramedic or Nurse, Practitioners for less complex matters. This enables us to save GP appointments for more complex matters. However, we do appreciate that some patients may feel uncomfortable sharing their 'problem' and are, therefore, under no obligation to do so. You will never be asked at the front reception desk.

Patient ACCESS Registration

You can now access your own Summary Medical Records. This will enable you to:

Access services and information day or night including your test results.

Book appointments without telephoning.

Order repeat prescriptions

You need to register for this internet service by completing our online form available on our website or ask at reception.

On registration (subject to the correct identification documents being authorised) you will be issued a unique user identity and password for your use only. Please note only one patient per email address so family and other persons in the household cannot access your or their medical information trough the same email.
